The Following Pages provides a brief description of our facilities.

AREAS LOCATED IN AND AROUND THE LOBBY

Parking Lot

Please feel free to use any of the three Lindenwood parking lots. All drivers must maintain a close lookout for children and maintain a safe speed. All vehicles must be parked in a parking space. Please do not park along side the curb and reserve our handicapped spaces for those with physical limitations.

Lobby

Check in and out, payments, general first aid kits, and incident report files are all located in the lobby.

Rest Rooms

The Life Center has restrooms located on the main floor, second floor, and in the Underground. We also have a restroom reserved for adults and the handicapped located on the main floor across from the Camp Office.

Lindy's Café

During Summer Camp, our Café serves breakfast, snacks, and lunches.

Kindergarten and First Grade Suite

The K-1 rooms, the two last rooms located on the south end of the main floor, includes learning centers, an arcade center, TV with VCR, games, and toys.

Gardens

Each summer, the Life Center develops several gardens for the campers to maintain. This year's gardens will be raised beds located on the patio behind the lobby.

AREAS LOCATED IN AND AROUND THE GYMNASIUM

Gymnasium

The gym is used for basketball, indoor games, skating, and assemblies.

The Loft

Located above the gym, the Loft serves as a classroom, practice facility for dance and cheerleading, and a dance floor.

Kidz Store

Kidz Store is open daily and is operated by our campers.

Skate Center

Campers may receive and return our skates from the Kidz Store window. Campers may use our skates or bring their own (indoor) skates from home. Skating occurs in the gym.

Climbing Wall

The climbing wall presents a 20 foot vertical challenge for kids of all ages. Children are belayed by trained staff to the top of the gym.

The Tunnel

Our newest area for our campers is called the Tunnel. This used to be our wood shop (moved next door). The room is 12 feet wide by 50 feet long, which lends us its name, the Tunnel. This is the homeroom for grades 8th-10th during the summer. It has arcade games, lounge area, games, and dining area.

Movie World

Located below the gym in the Underground, Movie World seats over 50 kids. We have a 60 inch plasma screen TV with surround sound, and a popcorn machine.

Camp Facilities

AREAS LOCATED IN AND AROUND THE PLAYGROUND

Playground

This is a great place to spend the day. The playground is complete with all modern, updated equipment. Each piece is designed to promote FUN and FITNESS at the same time.

Sand Box

Located next to the pavilion, the sandbox provides a place to play and use your imagination.

Slip and Slide

This 40-foot slide is a great place to cool off during the summer. Campers are required to wear a swim suit and wet shoes, and they must bring a towel.

Water Slide

Campers in grades K-3 will have access to our inflatable water slide which is located next to the batting cage on the west side of the playground. We will also rent larger water slides for all campers during Wet and Wild Weeks.

Batting Cage

The batting cage is often used during the summer for baseball classes.

Ball Field

Our ball field is an enclosed area in which our campers can run and play. Staff plan organized activities such as flag football, whiffle ball, kick ball, and weekly theme games.

Putt- Putt Course

This simple 3 hole course was built last year by Arthur Headly, a former Lindenwood child for his Eagle Scout Project. Test your putting skills.

AREAS LOCATED ON THE SECOND FLOOR

2nd and 3rd Grade Suite

Each grade group has its own suite. The 2nd & 3rd grade suite is located in rooms 204 and 205. Their suite contains educational and fun centers, arcades, and theater.

4th and 5th Grade Suite

Their suite is located in rooms 210 and 211. The rooms includes a lounge, library, computers and internet, arcades, music, TV with VCR, ping pong table, foosball, and board games.

6th and 7th Grade Suite

Their suite is located in rooms 208 and 209. Their suite includes a lounge, library, arcades, music, 32 inch flat screen TV with VCR, ping pong table, foosball, air hockey, and board games.

Arcade Center

We also have a larger arcade center for all campers located on the second floor above the lobby.
