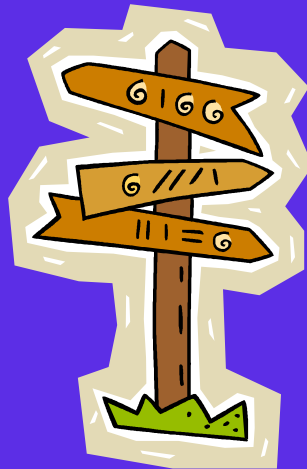

Road Trips & Field Trips

After reviewing our camp surveys, we decided that field trips and road trips were a huge success last summer.

The difference between a road trip and a field trip. Field trips are shorter and do not include a meal. Road Trips are longer and may take most of the day. They also involve both a lunch and an activity or event. All trips are optional and the cost may vary. The usual cost for a Road Trip is \$25. The cost of field trips will vary from FREE to \$10. All details will be posted on this site as they are confirmed.

This summer we have decided to make the following changes:

Discover Camp (K-2) will continue to have 4 Road Trips for the summer. Their trips will relate to the theme of that week. They may also have several field trips or guest speakers—also usually related to the theme of the week. Cost may vary.

Adventure Camp (3-6) will also have 4 Road Trips for the summer. All of their trips will occur on Fridays—usually from 9 am to 4 pm.

Challenge Camp (7-8) will have 4 Road Trips and weekly (usually 2-3) field trips per week. Their weekly camp tuition pays for their weekly field trips and road trips.

Summer Camp Homerooms

Kindergarten and 1st Grade Homerooms:

The K-1 rooms, the two last rooms located on the south end of the main floor, includes learning centers, an arcade center, TV with VCR, games, and toys.

2nd Grade Homeroom:

The 2nd graders homeroom is located in room 208. Their room has age appropriate games, learning centers, movie theater, and arcades.

3rd and 4th Grade Homerooms:

Each grade group has its own suite. The 2nd & 3rd grade suite is located in rooms 204 and 205. Their suite contains educational and fun centers, arcades, and movie theater.

5th and 6th Grade Homerooms:

Their suite is located in rooms 209 & 210. The rooms includes a lounge, library, computers and internet, arcades, music, TV with VCR, ping pong table, foosball, and board games.

7th and 8th Grade Homerooms:

Their suite is located in rooms 211 and fire place community room. Their suite includes a lounge, library, arcades, music, TV with VCR, computers and internet, ping pong table, foosball, air hockey, and board games.

Gymnasium



The gym is used for basketball, indoor games, skating, and assemblies.



The Loft



Located above the gym, the Loft has a two lane bowling alley which is used for classes and fun.



Skate Center



Campers may receive and return our skates from the Kidz Store window. Campers may use our skates or bring their own (indoor) skates from home. Skating occurs in the gym.

Climbing Wall (and outdoor climbing wall)

The climbing wall presents a 20 foot vertical challenge for kids of all ages. Children are belayed by trained staff to the top of the gym.



The Tunnel

One of our newer area for our campers is called the Tunnel. The room is 12 feet wide by 50 feet long, which lends us its name, the Tunnel. Even though many of the groups have their own arcade systems, The Tunnel is are primary Arcade Center with over 12 flat screen TVs and the latest arcade games.



Movie World

Located below the gym in the Underground, Movie World seats over 50 kids. We have a 60 inch plasma screen TV with surround sound, and a popcorn machine.

Backyard Patio and Outdoor Movie Theater



Playground

This is a great place to spend the day. The playground is complete with all modern, updated equipment. Each piece is designed to promote FUN and FITNESS at the same time.



Ball Field

Our ball field is an enclosed area in which our campers can run and play. Staff plan organized activities such as flag football, whiffle ball, kick ball, and weekly theme games.

Sand Box

Slip and Slide

This 40-foot slide is a great place to cool off during the summer. Campers are required to wear a swim suit and wet shoes, and they must bring a towel.
